

# Græsset er altid grønnere på den anden side – eller?

## Abstract

### The grass is always greener on the other side – or is it?

*In the past year, the debate over the privatization of development-led archaeology in Denmark has intensified (beginning with Dobat (2023)). During my internship at a Swedish archaeological company, I gained insight into the privatized model and its differences from the Danish system. In this context, I aim to contribute to the debate through my experiences from Sweden, often regarded as the prime example of commercialized archaeology. The ongoing debate is summarized and a shift in perspective is suggested - from questioning whether to commercialize or not, to considering the need for national databases and exploring the potential for developer-funded publication and research initiatives.*
