Reflections on the annual Iron Age seminar 2025

The Iron Age Seminar is an annual one-day meeting bringing together field archaeologists, students, and researchers to present and discuss new excavations, methods, and interpretations. Held on 26 September 2025 at Museum Midtjylland under the title All Quiet from the Iron Age? the seminar challenged the notion that Iron Age archaeology is dominated by repetitive settlement patterns and posthole data. Speakers were invited to present new, uncertain, or unconventional perspectives drawn from both old and recent material. The contributions demonstrated that the expanding dataset continues to generate fresh questions and insights, emphasising the Iron Age as a complex and dynamic period with considerable interpretative potential.

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
